



**Lumpkin County Parks and Recreation Department  
Board of Commissioners Monthly Report  
December 2016**

- I. Athletics
  - a. Youth basketball is our only active sport currently.
  - b. Baseball, Softball, and T-Ball registrations will begin in January.
  
- II. Programs
  - a. We had approximately 180 different participants in our programs this month, which were: After School, Winter Break Camp, Gymnastics, Tai Chi, and Dahlonga Moves Fitness. Please see the attached December 2016 Programs Report for the full breakdown.
  
- III. Community Center
  - a. We had 32 rentals/uses by various groups or individuals during the month of December. These include uses by the Rotary Club, Gideon's International, Blue Ridge Archaeological Guild, Lumpkin County Sheriff's Office, Lumpkin County Government, Lumpkin County Retired Educators, Lions Club, and several others.
  - b. Some of the events that were held at the Community Center were the Lions Club Pancake Breakfast, the Lumpkin County Government

Christmas Party, the Georgia Appalachian Trail Club Annual Meeting, and the Lumpkin County Sherriff's Department Christmas Party.

- c. There were approximately 400 participants during open gym.
- d. There were no major incidents involving repairs or other issues at the Community Center this month.

#### IV. Community House

- a. The Community House was rented by 4 different groups during December. The Dahlonega Women's Club had their Christmas Market. The Lumpkin County Historical Society had their monthly meeting. The Women's Club had their regular meeting. The Lumpkin/Dahlonega Chamber had their visioning meeting.
