



**Lumpkin County Parks & Recreation Department  
Board of Commissioners Monthly Report  
June, 2016**

- I. Athletics
  - A. 6 All-Star teams competed in the Dizzy Dean tournaments representing Lumpkin County. We had one Dizzy Dean District 6 Champion (10U Boys) and one Dizzy Dean District 6 Runner Up (8U Boys)! Both will be representing Lumpkin County in the Dizzy Dean State Tournaments in July.
  - B. UFA Soccer completed their Youth Summer Camp with over 30 participants.
  
- II. Programs
  - A. We have approximately 449 participants registered in the following programs; Gymnastics, Summer Day Camp, Adult Art, Swimming Lessons and BlastIt Fitness Body Blast 4 X 4. Please see the attached June, 2016 Programs Report for the breakdown.
  
- III. Community Center
  - A. We had approximately 35 rentals/uses by various groups during the month of June. These included uses by the Rotary Club, Gideon's International, Daughters of the American Revolution, Weight Watcher's, Lumpkin County Parks & Recreation Citizens Advisory Board meeting, Relay for Life meeting, Lumpkin County Family Connections, Lumpkin County Retired Educators Association, the Branch Church and Grace Fellowship Primitive Baptist Church.

- B. Some of the Special Events we had at the Community Center were meetings by the Lumpkin County Visionary Committee, FEMA and Lumpkin County Employees Open Enrollment.
  - C. We had approximately 300 participants during open gym.
- IV. Community House
- A. We had approximately 8 uses of the Community House by several groups including the Dahlongega Women's Club, Sons of the Confederate Veterans, Lumpkin County 4-H Club, Movie under the Stars HQ and the Lumpkin County Historical Society.
- V. Yahoola Creek Park, Reservoir Trail & Timken Pavilion
- A. Our Maintenance Crew continued to make significant strides in maintaining Yahoola Creek Park and the Reservoir Trail to the standards expected by the citizens of Lumpkin County. This has been a very busy summer with preliminary work taking place on upcoming playground installation behind Field #2.
  - B. Community Pool has been well used this June due to very good weather and recent improvements made at the pool.
  - C. Staff has continued to concentrate on keeping the park and fields ready for summer sports.
  - D. We had 11 rentals or uses of Timken Pavilion.
