



**Lumpkin County Parks & Recreation Department
Board of Commissioners Monthly Report
August, 2016**

- I. Athletics
 - A. Football games started with 5 teams representing Lumpkin County in ages 6 through 10. We also had cheerleader teams in those same age groups. There are 121 children registered for football and 69 children registered for cheerleading.
 - B. UFA Soccer completed their Youth Soccer registration. This year we have close to 300 registered for Fall Soccer

- II. Programs
 - A. We have approximately 221 participants registered in the following programs; Gymnastics / Tumbling, Summer Day Camp and BlastIt Fitness Body Blast 4 X 4. Please see the attached August, 2016 Programs Report for the breakdown.
 - B. Our After School Program has averaged around 77 children per week at Blackburn Elementary, Long Branch Elementary and Lumpkin County Elementary for a total of 335 participants

- III. Community Center
 - A. We had approximately 46 rentals/uses by various groups during the month of August. These included uses by the Rotary Club, Gideon's International, Daughters of the American Revolution,

Weight Watcher's, Lumpkin County Family Connections, the Branch Church and Grace Fellowship Primitive Baptist Church.

- B. Some of the Special Events we had at the Community Center were meetings by the Lumpkin County HR Department for Wellness Meetings, ConnectAbility Side Kicks Event, Chamber of Commerce Town Hall Meeting, Life Line Health Screenings, LC 4-H Parent Orientation Meeting, LC Youth Leadership Meeting and Georgia Secretary of State Brian Kemp's Young Ambassador Program.
 - C. We had approximately 525 participants during open gym.
- IV. Community House
- A. We had approximately 5 uses of the Community House by several groups including the Dahlonega Women's Club, Movie under the Stars HQ and the Lumpkin County Historical Society.
- V. Yahoola Creek Park, Legion Pool, Reservoir Trail & Timken Pavilion
- A. Our Maintenance Crew continued to make significant strides in maintaining Yahoola Creek Park and the Reservoir Trail to the standards expected by the citizens of Lumpkin County.
 - B. Legion Pool has been very busy due to very hot weather and recent improvements made at the pool.
 - C. We had 8 scheduled pool parties at Legion Pool.
 - D. Staff has continued to concentrate on keeping the park and fields ready for summer/fall sports.
 - E. We had 7 scheduled rentals or uses of Timken Pavilion.
 - F. Work was completed on our new ADA compliant "Playground for children of all abilities" in Yahoola Creek Park.
