Farm Wineries Discount Pricing: The highest cost license category will be the "first license". Any license for **two** (2) categories shall be at the price of the first license category **plus \$250.00**. Any license for **three** (3) or more categories shall be at the price of the first license category **plus \$500.00**. These are only for Farm Winery categories and do not apply to the categories on the next page.

Applications also require \$350 to be added for administrative & investigative fees,

Farm Wineries - A farm winery may apply for and if approved, may be issued multiple licenses for any single site. At the primary farm winery facility where the wine is produced, such site may be licensed for manufacture, wholesale, package retail sales and on-premise consumption. For any site other than the primary farm winery facility (where the wine is produced), up to the maximum number of such sites as may be permitted by Georgia statute, such site may be licensed for package retail sales and on-premise consumption. Each site will require a separate license.

The highest cost license category will be the "first license". Any license for two (2) categories shall be at the price of a single license plus \$250.00. Any license for three (3) or more categories shall be at the price of a single license plus \$500.00. These are only for Farm Winery categories and do not apply to the categories on the next page. Any application to add a category of license to an existing license at a time other than the annual renewal shall be at the price set above for each additional category plus an administrative fee of \$150.00.
